Add second authorization in COB box.

Must have a routine diagnosis code in addition to medical diagnosis code.

Essential Medical** Benefit

Bill for exam, refraction and medical procedure(s) remaining balance.

VSP will deny refraction (bill patient).

Note: Essential Medical does not cover refraction – if performed, a routine diagnosis code is required, see Situation 1.

SITUATION THREE

Refractive Diagnosis Codes

Exam and Refraction Prescription Eyewear

Bill Primary Vision Plan

Non-VSP Vision plan partially covers Exam and Materials

COB VSP Electronically

(eClaim, Acuity, Office Mate, EPM) (single claim – even same day) Keep copy of EOP* in patient's chart

WellVision Benefit

Bill for exam, refraction and eyewear remaining balance.

Note: WellVision benefit will not cover medical procedures – if performed, a medical diagnosis code is required, see Situation 1.

- 1. Doctor bills medical exam and refraction with a valid refractive diagnosis code. COB allowed under Essential Medical** for exam/procedures and WellVision exam to pick up refraction.
- 2. Doctor bills medical exam and refraction with medical diagnosis only. COB allowed only with Essential Medical** for exam overage, excluding refraction.
- 3. Doctor bills WellVision plan for exam, refraction and eyewear with refractive diagnosis only. COB allowed only with WellVision benefits for exam, refraction and eyewear.

Note: For VSP-to-VSP COB, you can only coordinate WellVision to WellVision or Medical benefits. If patient received refractive and medical services, bill two separate claims.
